WORDS OF REMEMBRANCE	If the family wishes to have one person speak about the deceased, they are invited to do so at the beginning of our liturgy.	PERSON SPEAKING:	
	The reflection should not be longer than 5 minutes and we strongly encourage the speaker to have a prepared text.	RELATIONSHIP TO DECEASED:	
FUNERAL PALL or	When the body is present, a funeral pall which is placed over the casket represents the loved one's baptismal garment. It reminds us of God's promise to be with us	PALL WILL BE PLACED ON THE CASKET BY:	
PROCESSION OF REMAINS	always and lead us to heaven when we were baptized.	URN WILL BE CARRIED IN PROCESSION BY:	
	If an urn is present, there is no funeral pall but the remains are carried in procession.		
OLD TESTAMENT READING	One of the ways God speaks to us is through Sacred Scripture. The First Reading comes from the Old Testament which	PLEASE CHOOSE AN OLD TESTAMENT READING: #	
	reminds us to always look for the coming of the Messiah. (The numbered readings are selected from a booklet online or a hard copy that we provide.)	PERSON READING:	
NEW TESTAMENT READING	The second reading describes the early Church as it began to proclaim the Good News of the Resurrection. Most often the reading comes from one of the letters of St. Paul. (If you do not have anyone to proclaim the readings, someone from the parish will volunteer to do that)	PLEASE CHOOSE A NEW TESTAMENT READING: # PERSON READING:	
GOSPEL	The gospel tells us the story of Jesus and his mission to save us. The gospel reading invites us to gaze towards heaven.	PLEASE CHOOSE A GOSPEL READING: #	
PRAYERS OF THE FAITHFUL	This is an opportunity for us to place before the Lord our prayers and needs during this most difficult and challenging time.	PERSON READING THE PRAYERS:	
OFFERTORY PROCESSION	There is an option to invite family or friends to present the gifts of BREAD and WINE that are used for the celebration of the Eucharist.
